The Early Migration Period in Silesia

Abstract:

The early migration period in Silesia is a very interesting time, time of development of settlement structures in Sudeten mountains. In few cases hilltop settlements are identified. It is a time of prosperity of wheel thrown pottery workshops with kilns and time of a great diversity of pottery forms. In funeral rite few eye-catching behaviors are noticeable (graves without any accessory, dismembered, decapitated bodies). Elements of nomadic origin can be also observed in that time. The early migration period is finally a time of a great cultural differentiation in particular settlement microregions.
