28. International Conference The Early and Middle Bronze Age in Central Europe

Vémyslice (CZ) / 16th–20th October 2023

Conference Orientation Program:

Monday 16th October: - to 13.00 - arrival of participants, then the start of the conference, afternoon lectures, joint dinner, free program

Tuesday 17th October: 9.00 – 18.00 - lectures, shared lunch, dinner, free program

Wednesday 18th October: 9.00 – 18.00 - lectures, shared lunch; 19.00 – depending on fatigue - social evening

Thursday 19th October: full-day excursion, joint dinner, wine tasting for those interested, free program

Friday 20th October: 9.00 – 12.00 - lectures, end of conference, lunch optional, departure of participants

Participants will receive the preliminary conference program (list of registered papers and posters, excursion program etc.) in June 2023 (if applications are submitted in time), the final program in September 2023.

Basic organizational information:

Please strictly adhere to the set limit of 15 minutes, in order to gain enough time to discuss each contribution immediately after it ends and to use the presence of a number of experts to exchange observations on the given issue. The titles of the papers should be concise and as brief as possible, because the communication of their content is the subject of the presentation itself.

We ask the authors to respect that the only possible form of presentation (apart from posters) is a PowerPoint presentation - no other technique will be available.

The maximum poster format is **DIN A0** (841 x 1189 mm)

We ask all authors of presentations and posters to think about our foreign participants and, if they will be presenting their contribution in Czech/Slovak, to be so kind as to prepare their PowerPoint presentation in English or German (i.e. with English or German texts), or provided their poster with at least a brief English summary.





The conference fee of CZK 1,500 (students CZK 800) includes refreshments during the break, the cost of renting the conference hall and equipment, transport to the excursion and a social evening.

Please pay the conference fee to account No. 1581165309/0800, variable symbol 92738, with your name included in the note. The deadline for payment of the fee is 31st May 2023.

Accommodation and catering

Accommodation is provided directly at the venue of the conference, i.e. in the Ryšavý hotel complex in Vémyslice – WGS84 49.0209469N, 16.2588644E (<https://www.hotelrysavy.cz/>), where shared meals will also be provided and a social evening will also take place here.

We have reserved 50 beds designed as double rooms. If more capacity is needed, it is possible that some of the conference participants will be accommodated in a triple or quadruple room. This is unfortunately due to an unexpected change in the organization of our meeting. If you have a preferred roommate, please include it in the notes on the application form.

The price of accommodation is 1,341 CZK/ 1 night/ 1 person when the rooms are fully occupied. If there is a request for the room to be occupied by only one person, the price is CZK 1,566/1 night/room.

We are also sending a menu in the e-mail attachment, please tick your preferred meal.

Upon prior arrangement, it is possible to arrange transportation from Pohořelice or Moravský Krumlov.
